NSS Activity Report 2021-22

1. Tree Plantation:

The tree plantation program was conducted by the college in campus on 19.10.22 through the department of NSS. About 100 plants were planted through the auspicious hands of Shri. Jaysingrao Hujare, Shri. Sarjerao Patil, Shri. Baban Patil, Shri. Vilas Patil, Shri. Bandopant Vadkar. NSS programme officers along with all faculty members, administrative staff and 75 NSS voluteers participated in the program. Saptaparni, *Cassia siamea*, Golden shower tree, Karanj, Kanchanar, Amla, Eucalyptus, Rain tree, Drooping ashok, *Ficus* and other ornamental species of plants were planted.

2. Forest Conservation Activity: Cleanliness Campaign at Radhanagari Forest

Two days Cleanliness campaign was organized at Radhanagari Wildlife Sanctuary on 20.12.2021 in collaboration with Shivaji University, Kolhapur and Dainik Pudhari Extension wing. Total 50 volunteers from 6 NSS units of senior colleges near sanctuary and their programme officers were participated in this campaign. Claenliness drive in Butterfly garden; Sanctuary office, Hatti Mahal area and other historical places have been carried out to clean the area and make the area plastic free. Glass bottles, pieces of glasses and plastic bottles were also collected and sent for disposal. One programme officer Dr. T. M. Chougale and 10 volunteers were participated in the campaign.





3. Mask Distribution:

The mask distribution program was organized by the NSS unit of Bhogawati Mahavidyalaya, Kurukali in remote villages for offering protection to the peoples from Corona Virus infection. About 500 masks were distributed to the peoples in Hanabarwadi, Keloshi, and Padasali by the NSS volunteers. The program was organized under "Maze gaon, Mazi Shala, Mazi Jababdari" Scheme. The awareness about Covid - 19 and its hazards among the peoples was created by the programme officer and NSS volunteers.





4. Corona Vaccination Campaign:

National Service Scheme in collaboration with Medical officer and his team of Hasur PHC organized Covid-19 Vaccination campaign for the college students on 05.01.2022. The first dose of Covid-19 vaccine was given to 650 + students in college. Principal Prof. R. A. Sarnobat, Vice principal Dr. N. M. Patil and NSS Programme officer Dr. T. M. Chougale, Prof. Kiran Patil, Pavan Patil along with NSS volunteers actively organized the camp. The dose of Covishield was given as per the guideline of WHO and IMC. Necessary precautions were taken during the vaccination. About 85 NSS volunteers participated in the activity.





5. River Cleanliness Drive:

The department of NSS through its volunteers conducted River Cleanliness drive in Bhogawati River at Parite on 21.04.2022. Plastic waste including scrappers, bags, bottles, pouches and waste plastic along with other organic wastes and old cloths were collected by the NSS volunteers. About 60 volunteers, Programme officer Dr. T. M. Chougale and non-teaching staff involved in the drive. Principal, Prof. R. A. Sarnobat supported the activity.





6. Gender Sensitization Activity:

Gender sensitization program was organized in college on 05 Jan., 2022 and 08 March, 2022 through NSS unit. On January, 5th in collaboration with NGO the program under the title "Jabardastit Kasali Mardangi" the awareness program was organized by the NSS volunteers in campus and in Kurukali Village. The posters were distributed among the peoples and were displayed at the public places. On 8th March, 2022 Women's day was celebrated for creating awareness among college students. Dr. Shobha Patil guided the students about gender awareness. NSS Program officers, staff and 65 volunteers were attended the program.
